MEET THE PRES. TOMORROW



DENVER -- Pres. Morgan Carroll will have her next Meet the Pres. briefing tomorrow, Thursday, Feb. 27. The briefing is an open forum for journalists to ask questions about policy. Every week, we will highlight a specific topic, and invite another Senator to speak about it.

Tomorrow, Meet the Pres. will highlight what the legislature is doing to keep public schools and the environment healthy.

Sen. Rachel Zenzinger, D-Arvada, will speak about SB 14-124, the School Turnaround Leaders Development Program. The program will help low-performing K-12 schools better serve students and communities.



Sen. Mary Hodge, D-Brighton, will speak about HB 14-1077, a bipartisan effort that ensures the Oil and Gas Conservation and Environmental Response Fund has enough resources for critical environmental response and cleanup.
